1. **Mr Heggarty appointed as new Principal** – following a recruitment process by the Education Authority over December/January, I am delighted to share with you all the news that I have been formally appointed as the new Principal of Cregagh Primary School. I consider this a great privilege. I came to Cregagh Primary School in 1999 (20 years ago!), having taught in Avoniel Primary for 3 years. So for me to be appointed the new Principal is just fantastic. I look forward to new and exciting things here at Cregagh Primary!
2. **School Secretary** – we are also delighted to welcome onto our school staff Miss Murphy, our new permanent school secretary. It will take her some time to learn the 1001 different jobs that a busy school office demands but you will find she is very friendly and extremely helpful.

5. **P1 Enrolment** – I've thought carefully about including this last item on this Friday note but I think parents need to be made aware of the lower than normal number of P1 applications we received this year – only 17 for September 2019. While 17 is a lovely size of a class for a child to be part of, it decimates school finances. Over the past year, Cregagh Primary School has featured regularly in the press and media, we have spent generously on advertising, we have had excellent open day events for pre-schoolers and their families such as our Carnival and Breakfast with Santa events. We offer Family Learning opportunities. We have a School Counsellor. Our school outperforms many neighbouring schools' academic results and rivals many others. All our pupils are well cared for. Every year group enjoys at least 2 out-of-school trips each year. And during the ongoing Industrial Action by teachers' unions, we have continued to provide our boys and girls with after school clubs, not to mention lots of training opportunities for their parents! Lastly, we are once again staging a school show at the end of what will have been a fabulous school year!

So, parents of Cregagh – share the good news stories about Cregagh Primary School! At the moment our pupil numbers are healthy but we all need to work together to keep them that way. If Cregagh Primary School is "At the Heart of its Community", we need to look after that heart together.
