1. AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS & TWO-TO-THREE WAITING CLUB

- We look forward to restarting our after-school clubs next week. Information has already gone home about Two-to-Three Club recommencing on Monday 7th March about how parents can register and book places using our schools online booking system, *SchoolMoney*.
- A range of after-school clubs will start next week. The clubs are for P4 to P7 pupils and are not compulsory; they are designed to engage and develop children's interests. We want the children who attend to want to be there, so they should not be seen or used as "childcare". The most popular clubs may have to have maximum number restrictions, in which case some children may have to wait until after Easter to attend that particular club but everyone should get their turn. Just like the normal school day, we expect the same high standards of good behaviour from all children attending after-school clubs: it is still part of school ©
- Parents are responsible for making sure they know on which days their children are going to clubs and children should be clear on how they are expected to travel home: collected by a known adult or walk home alone (school has to have been given permission for this to happen).

Until we are totally out-of-the-woods, please stay vigilant, test children when necessary & keep children off when necessary. Remember that we continue to keep our classrooms well ventilated to help combat Covid infection. Please make sure your children wear enough layers of clothing to school to keep them warm.
