- Morning drop-off time our new morning routines are starting to bed-in now. Parents of children who enter school by the rear school gate must drop their children off at the yellow gates and not come into the playground area which is to be kept clear for children to play. Once on school grounds, children are safe: providing any adults who are not school staff have left the school premises. School staff are on duty every morning. From Monday 5<sup>th</sup> September only P1 parents will be able to walk across the playground area. Speak to your child's class teacher if unsure.
- 2. Meet the Teacher Afternoon On Wednesday 7th September at 2pm, all P2-P7 parents and carers are invited to come to school to meet their child's new classroom teacher and find out about the year ahead including: the topics your child will learn about, what is expected from them regarding homework, school trips and visits, etc. Parents with more than one child attending school may choose which class teacher's meeting they wish to attend (they will also receive a copy of any written information given out by their other child's class teacher. All P2-P7 pupils will be supervised by school staff from 2pm onwards. More details will be sent home at the start of next week).
- 3. Breakfast Club & other school extra-curricular activities Breakfast Club restarts on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> September. Doors open at 8:15am. Children coming to Breakfast Club should not arrive at school earlier than 8:15am as they will not be supervised & this is unsafe. Places must be prebooked & paid online. Due to the current cost-of-living crisis, Cregagh PS is temporarily reducing the cost from its usual £1 down to 50p per day to help our school families out.
- 4. Two-to-Three Waiting Club (P1-P3 only) and After School Clubs we plan to start these week beginning Monday 12<sup>th</sup> September. More details to follow.
- 5. Attendance target for all pupils 2022-23 The Department of Education (NI) states that a child with an attendance record of 95% is only just "satisfactory", as 95% means that 9 days of learning have been lost. As a school, we want to see all children in school every day and on time. Missing days of school or being late for reasons that could easily be avoided sends a message to children that school and education "doesn't really matter". Children only get one shot at school; help them make the most of their opportunity.

- 6. School Fund Most school staff are parents themselves or aunts or uncles and understand that money doesn't grow on trees especially at the moment! However, without school fund contributions the boys and girls would miss out on a lot of things. The amount remains at £20 *per family* per school year. This can be paid through our online payment system School Money in either one or several instalments.
- 7. Healthy breaks, no nuts & water only Our school has a Healthy Break Policy: only healthy break foods can be eaten Monday-Thursday. On Fridays, children can bring a 'sweet treat' to school if they so choose. Children may only bring water to school to drink for break and lunch (not diluted juice). Visit our school website for some healthy break ideas. Our school pupils' dental health was among the worst in East Belfast 20 years ago, now it's among the best. Lastly, please remember we are a 'nut free' school due to some children and staff having allergies.
- School Photographer our school photographer will be in school on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> September to take individual & school family photos of pupils (who attend Cregagh PS). Parents are under no obligation to purchase photographs.
