1. **Harvest Assembly** - on Thursday 27th October, we plan to hold a special harvest assembly. As in past years (pre-Covid), any parents who wish to join us would be very welcome. It will start at 9:15am and last for approximately 30 minutes. The school choir will be singing, some poetry will be read and one of our local ministers will be speaking to the children for a short while.

In the days leading up to this assembly, school will be accepting donations of tinned and packet foods for redistribution among families in the immediate area who, like so many, are struggling with the cost of living right now. If you can spare a tin or packet or two (please make sure they have a long expiry date left ©) please send it into school with your child for our collection table. If you feel you can't spare anything at the moment, don't worry!

- 2. **Parent-Teacher Interviews** these will take place week beginning Monday 24th October. As in past years, children will go home at 1pm each day to enable staff to meet with parents.
 - Only those with legal parental rights (known to the school) can attend. No other relatives <u>unless</u> they have PR.
 - o Each parent will have 10 minutes with their child's teacher.
 - o We want to see all parents attend these important meetings about their children's learning and welfare.
 - Letters have gone home on Thursday this week asking parents to suggest a day which suits them best.
 Please return these letters ASAP so that the teachers can try to accommodate any requests you might have.
- 3. Is your child entitled to Free School Meals? For every eligible child registered for Free School Meals (regardless of whether they ever take them or not), schools in N.I. receive additional funding. - 4. No smoking or vaping anywhere on school grounds or near the school gates please remember this. Thanks.
- 5. **Opportunities for parents to get involved** Lois Corbett, our lovely Family Engagement Worker, has put together a great programme of activities for parents to engage with.
- 6. **Coats in school** as the weather is starting to change, please send your child in to school with a coat especially important if they are taking part in outdoor play or wanting to stay warm during playing at break and lunch time.
