1. Applying for a P1 Place at Cregagh Primary School for September 2023

School Age

Children born between 2 July 2018 and 1 July 2019 will be due to start Primary One in September 2023 as they will be of compulsory school age and Parents/Guardians must apply for a place in a primary school. The School Age (NI) Act became law in Northern Ireland on 28 April 2022 and has changed the law to allow the parents/guardians of <u>younger children</u> in the year group a choice to defer their child starting primary school by one year should they wish to do so.


This applies only to children:

- o Born on or between 1 April 2019 and 1 July 2019 or
- Born before 1 April 2019 but due to be born on or after 1 April 2019 if born at term (Medical evidence must be provided).

Parents of these children can decide to defer P1 for one year and apply for pre-school. Further information on Deferral of School Starting Age is available on the Department of Education website under *School Starting Age*.

The EA Connect School Applications portal will open at **12.00 noon on Tuesday 10 January 2023** and close at **12.00 noon on Friday 27 January 2023**.

3. Two-to-Three Waiting Club

- Our Two-to-Three Waiting Club is for parents who have children in P1-P3 and also have children in P4-P7.
- It is not after-school childcare for just any child: Two-to-Three Waiting Club is a paid-for service aimed primarily at working parents who would otherwise have to do a double pick-up at 2pm & 3pm on Mondays to Thursdays.
- As there are limited spaces, they are distributed giving priority to P1 children with older brother/sister in P4-P7 first; then P2 children with older brother/sister in P4-P7 second; and lastly P3 children with older brother/sister in P4-P7.

4. Pupils and School Carpark

Please note that pupils and parents should not walk across the school's carpark. This is a school safety rule that is taught to the girls and boys from P1 and so it's confusing if parents, perhaps running late, do this with their children. <u>Please use the pedestrian gate only</u>. Thank you.
