#### 1. Parent/Teacher Interview Week

Free School Meals Schools in Northern Ireland receive additional funding according to the percentage of its pupils entitled and registered for Free School Meals (FSM). I would ask all parents who think they may be entitled to FSM but currently aren't registered to apply. Whether or not their children actually use them is a completely different matter. Like most primary schools across NI, we are facing a 'perfect storm' of a small P1 class coming in September 2023, lower numbers of children registered for FSM, and the DE's 10% cuts across all government departments and the EA's £110 Million own cuts. #### 3. Book Fair


