


The Wee Friday Note Friday 10th November 2023



- 1. Industrial Action on Thursday 16th November & impact on school
 Unions representing non-teaching staff have called for a day of industrial action (strike)
 on Thursday 16th November. Non-teaching staff are support staff that are essential to
 the safe and effective running of schools, and they do many different roles within our
 schools. As a result of this action taking place, Cregagh PS, like many other schools,
 will not be able to operate due to a shortage of key staff. Consequently, Cregagh PS
 will be closed to ALL pupils on Thursday 16th November.






Were you able to arrange a suitable day & time for your Parent-Teacher Interview, okay? ²⁴ responses




Did you find the discussion with the teacher(s) useful? 24 responses




Do you feel you learned an adequate amount about how your child is doing in school at present? ^{24 responses}




Were you given opportunity to ask the teacher(s) questions about your child's learning? ^{24 responses}




We're you given any ideas by the teacher(s) on how you can help support your child's learning at home? (with homework, reading, learning tables & spellings, etc)


In general, do you as a parent feel the staff at Cregagh Primary School are easy to talk to when you need to?



School Response:

Thank you very much for your responses; which will all be given careful thought. Overall., we are very pleased & it is so nice for staff feel appreciated.

- The idea of a "music day" (or similar) will be explored and hopefully we can do something with this.
- The last response does a very good job of highlighting the lack of funding across Northern Ireland's schools & its impact. We would certainly love to be able to provide additional Learning Support hours; this year it was very difficult to provide 3 days. I would stress that all children receive "learning support" from their class teachers, as work is differentiated for all pupils. No child is left floundering. Out-of-class Learning Support does not make a difference to all children, but it certainly can to others. Certainly, more funding would allow us to provide additional teaching hours for children who we know would benefit from their assessment data and classroom observations.
