- 1. **Cash-4-Clobber** thank you for supporting today's fund raising effort by donating your family's old clothes. If you couldn't bring them today, or if you find more, you can always deposit your unwanted clothing in the blue container beside our school clock tower.
- Family Holidays we understand that families want to avail of better-priced holidays in May/June/September and that some parents may be restricted as to when they can take time off work to go on holiday. However, no UK school can 'approve' a family taking children out of school during term-time. Families choosing to take their children on holiday during term-time must remember that their child's absence <u>has</u> to be recorded using the Department of Education's Code "G" – 'Unapproved Family Holiday'.
- 3. **Packed Lunches** a number of staff are concerned about the unhealthy nature of a growing number of children's packed lunches. Too many are filled with high-fat, high-sugar 'treats' rather than healthy and filling foods. Cregagh Primary School operates a healthy eating policy Monday to Friday, with Friday break time ("Fun Friday") being the exception. The children need foods that will give them sustained energy release throughout their day at school, rather than the high spikes and low drops of sugary foods. Also please remember, <u>water only</u> and <u>no nuts</u>!
